Chowan Perquimans Smart Start Partnership Training Descriptions

CPR/First Aid Training

Participant will learn how to perform CPR/First Aid. Also, learn the rules and regulations for administering both.

Emergency Preparedness & Response in Child Care

Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) in Child Care Training provides early educators with information and tools to prepare for many types of emergencies. The EPR in Child Care Training addresses NC Child Care Rules on emergency preparedness, current best practice recommendations, and guidance on completing the online EPR Plan.

ITS/SIDS

This required training explains all the parts of North Carolina's SIDS Law. Participants will review information about when and how to use the approved waivers, how to best place a baby in bed to sleep, and other "Best Practice" recommendations. During the workshop, participants will get the needed information to create a Safe Sleep Policy, updated research about SIDS, and local health and safety resources. Participants also will be walked through how to do an unresponsive infant drill and the reason for doing them regularly.

Medication in Child Care

Participants will learn medication best practices in early care and education including receiving, documenting, storage, and disposal. They will learn about NC Child Care regulations, types of medication, and the forms that are required to be completed before giving medication. They will also learn the six rights of medication administration, as well as how to recognize, respond to, and report a medication error. This training does not prepare participants to give medication to children. Additional in-depth, in-person, skills based training should be undertaken by early educators who will responsible for giving medication to children.

Medication Administration Skills

This required training explains all the parts of North Carolina's SIDS Law. Participants will review information about when and how to use the approved waivers, how to best place a baby in bed to sleep, and other "Best Practice" recommendations. During this event, learners will discuss how to properly administer medications to children by using the six rights to passing medications i.e. the right child, right medication, right time, right dose, right route, and right documentation. The learner will be able to explain the types of doses, identify routes of administration and recognize abbreviations. At the completion, learners will be able to administer medication according to the rules and regulations of NC and capable of correctly completing the medication administration record (MAR).

Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma/Child Abuse & Neglect

Participants will increase knowledge of prevention and recognition of child abuse and neglect, identify ways to respond to child maltreatment and understand he reporting process, and understand the impact of compassion fatigue and resilience on early educators and the children and families they serve. Participants will learn the definitions of Shaken Baby Syndrome/Abusive Head Trauma (SBS/AHT) and ow this type of abuse effects a young child. They will learn about early brain development, infant crying, and prevention of SBS/AHT.
