Chowan Perquimans Smart Start Partnership Training Descriptions

Administration of Medication Part 1 & Part 2

Participants will learn rules and regulations of N.C. safety, medication, and sanitation requirements to assure the safety of children while in your care. Participants will learn six rights to passing medications and also completing medication administration record.

Be Active Kids

Be-Active Kids meet best practices for early childhood physical activity. This training encourages children to explore their natural surroundings, engage in playful experiences, and fun being physically active. Once a provider has been trained in the Be-Active Kids Program, they are asked to return to their children and begin implementing the program.

Bloodborne Pathogens in Child Care

Participants will learn about infectious disease and how it is spread. The bloodborne Pathogens Standard 1910.1030 is the law that prescribes safeguards to protect workers against health hazards caused by exposure to bloodborne pathogens. This training covers the requirements of OSHA's bloodborne pathogen standard and how it applies.

Building & Physical Premises Safety

Participants will learn methods to recognize and minimize common hazards that exist in the building and physical premises of early care and education settings. They will learn about hazards from fire/burns, lead, choking/suffocation, slips/trips/falls, or injuries outdoors, water and sun, and transportation. They will learn how to create safe indoor and outdoor learning environments.

Children with Special Health Care Needs

Training developed by the North Carolina Child Care Health and Safety Resource Center covering information about children with special health care needs. ADA inclusion requirements, care teams for children with special health care needs, the role of the Child Care Health Consultant, required documentation for children with special health care needs and for handling medical emergencies at the child care facility.

Creative Ideas for Physical Activities

Participants will learn the importance of movement and physical activity. Participants will also learn how to plan for physical activity, scheduling physical activity & planning with daily themes. Participants will do hands on physical activities.

CPR/First Aid Training

Participant will learn how to perform CPR/First Aid. Also, learn the rules and regulations for administering both.

Diabetes in Childcare

Participants will learn about: route care of Type 1 Diabetes (communication with family and health care professionals counting carbohydrates, checking blood glucose, and administering insulin). How to recognize and respond to signs and symptoms of high and low blood glucose, how to provide first aid for emergency situations, including checking ketones and administering glucagon, the proper use and storage of insulin and glucagon, and required documentation.

Emergency Preparedness & Response in Child Care

Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) in Child Care Training provides early educators with information and tools to prepare for many types of emergencies. The EPR in Child Care Training addresses NC Child Care Rules on emergency preparedness, current best practice recommendations, and guidance on completing the online EPR Plan.

Fire Safety

Participant will learn the use of fire extinguishers and get information to help them learn about ABC's of fire extinguishers and how to perform visual inspections when having to make a split-second decision on whether or not to attempt to fight a fire or call 911. Training will also include how to spot fire hazards and how to access 911 system and changes to our community 911 procedures.

Handling & Storage of Hazardous Materials & The Appropriate Disposal

This course teaches how early child educators can minimize exposure to hazardous materials and toxic substances. Participants will learn to identify and avoid common indoor hazards to keep both adults and children safe in child care. Participants will also learn about NC Child Care and NC Sanitation rules regarding safe use of and storage of hazardous materials and toxic substances. Participants will also learn methods to recognize and minimize common hazards that exist in the building and physical premises of early care and education settings. They will learn about hazards from fire/burns, lead, choking/suffocation, slips/trips/falls or injures outdoors, water and sun, and transportation. They will learn how to create safe and outdoor learning environments.

ITS/SIDS

Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within four months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare home providers licensed to care for infants.

Playground Safety

This Training will cover the importance of appropriate supervision in childcare. We will cover proper supervision at mealtimes, naptime, and during free play indoors and out on the playground. This training will discuss developmentally appropriate supervision for infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and school-age children and the NC Child Care rules regarding supervision. Through scenarios, we will practice these skills and teachers will learn appropriate techniques to help keep children they serve safe while in their care.

Prevention & Response of Allergies & Infectious Disease

Participants will learn how to recognize signs and symptoms of severe allergic reactions, including anaphylaxis. Participants will also learn about infectious disease and how infectious disease spreads.

Shaken Baby Syndrome

Participants will learn that Shaken Baby Syndrome is a serious brain injury resulting from forcefully shaking an infant or toddler. Participants will learn Shaken Baby Syndrome usually occurs when a parent or caregiver severely shakes a child in frustration, or anger, often because the child won't stop crying. Permanent brain damage or death may result.

Wellness & Nutrition

This workshop will prepare Child care providers with physical activity and nutrition standards for Child care, as well as moving towards an active and healthy lifestyle for the future.
