## **Chowan Perquimans Smart Start Partnership Training Descriptions**

**CPR/First Aid Training** Participants will learn how to perform CPR/First Aid. Also, learn the rules and regulations for administering both.

**Emergency Preparedness & Response in Child Care** Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) in Child Care Training provides early educators with information and tools to prepare for many types of emergencies. The EPR in Child Care Training addresses NC Child Care Rules on emergency preparedness, current best practice recommendations, and guidance on completing the online EPR Plan.

### **Fire Safety**

Participants will learn the use of fire extinguishers and get information to help them learn about ABC's of fire extinguishers and how to perform visual inspections when having to make a split-second decision on whether or not to attempt to fight a fire or call 911. Training will also include how to spot fire hazards and how to access 911 system and changes to our community 911 procedures.

### **ITS/SIDS**

Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within four months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare home providers licensed to care for infants.

**Nurturing Young Children's Social & Emotional Development** Participants will learn the definitions of social and emotional development, understand the importance of nurturing young children's social and emotional development, and the role of caregivers in nurturing social and emotional development in young children. This hands-on-training will give participants insight on key components including emotional awareness, emotional competence, social interactions, empathy, self-awareness, and self-regulation.
