Snow People (Ages 4 and Up):

Gather the following materials: recycled craft rolls, construction paper, glue, scissors, pom poms, ribbon and pipe cleaners. Buttons and gems are also great to use for outfits! Whenever possible, allow the children to create on their own.

- 1. Cut a piece of white construction paper the length of the craft roll.
- 2. Glue the paper around the roll and allow to dry.
- Cut a pipe cleaner to size and glue pom poms to the sides for earmuffs. As they dry, add wiggly eyes and make a nose with construction paper for the face.
- Glue on buttons, tie a piece of ribbon around the neck and add any other accessories to your snowperson.

Big Heart Valentine's Cards (An activity for toddlers): Create a memorable Valentine's Day gift that parents will cherish for years to come!

Before you begin: Pre-cut heart shapes out of white construction paper. Older children may be able to cut out their own hearts. If they are developmentally ready, let them do it.

Steps to follow:

- Cover the bottom of children's hands or feet in washable paint—or dab onto a washable stamp pad.
- 2. One at a time, carefully make prints in heart shape.
- 3. When dry, mount onto colorful construction paper.
